

Using Doodle to build positive learning skills

Case study: Calder House School, Wiltshire



Calder House School have been using Doodle as a homework tool for over three years.

We spoke to Chiquita, the school's Maths Lead, about how it has helped to keep pupils motivated and spark their love of learning.

We use it as an online homework tool. We encourage children to earn 10 stars a day and ask for every child to be in the green zone (a zone they can reach by earning the target number of stars set for them by Doodle). All children are asked to spend 5 minutes per day on Doodle.

How do you encourage children to use Doodle?

We give out merits for using DoodleMaths and certificates for various achievements (e.g. greatest streak, class with everyone in the green zone and biggest improvement) in Friday's assembly.

My class also receive merits based on being in the green zone each day and whether the whole class is in the green zone. Merits are also given out, particularly for holiday homework. For this, they get merits for their streaks, reaching a given target and staying in the green zone.
