

Boost pupils' confidence with Doodle!



Case study: New York Primary School, Tyne and Wear

Used as a whole-school learning solution, New York Primary School use Doodle to boost their pupils' confidence and consolidate their knowledge. We spoke to Julia, a Year 5 teacher, about how Doodle has helped to keep students on track following periods of disrupted learning.



Hi Julia! Please could you give us a brief overview of how you use Doodle in your school?

We used Doodle across the school and each class has two sessions per week ... We encourage the use of Doodle at home and use certificates to reward the pupils who do so. We have also used Doodle as part of our remote learning, encouraging pupils to use it 'little and often' every day.

How do you encourage pupils to use Doodle?

We have a Doodle trophy that is sent to a winning class each week. We also have a Doodle Leaderboard in school ... in a central place that's shown in whole school assemblies. We use certificates to award pupils who have gained a high amount of stars in the week. Each term, we also give out Doodle pencils, rulers [and] stickers to those who have worked hard.

Has Doodle had an impact on pupils' confidence and attainment?
